



## Betty Lee Brannock

August 3, 1924 - August 26, 2013

Betty Lee (Kisling) Brannock of Rock Hall, MD, died on August 26, 2013, at home. She was 89.

She was born on August 3, 1924, in Curtis Bay, MD, the daughter of the late William Shade and Rena Frances (Durham) Kisling. She was a graduate of Eaton and Burnett Business College.

On July 3, 1942, she married Vernon Edward Brannock. and they lived in Chestertown, MD, where she raised her family. In 1978, they moved to Port Charlotte, FL. In 1995, her husband predeceased her. She moved to Weyers Cave, VA, from 1999 until 2007 when she returned to her beloved Eastern Shore, living in Rock Hall, MD.

As a family the Brannock's resided in Chestertown near the site of Caulk's Field, and gave much of their time and talents to Camp Fairlee Manor. Mrs. Brannock enjoyed bowling with her husband in her younger years, playing cards, sewing, fishing, doing embroidery, reading, and working in her flower gardens.
