



Betty B. Cokrill

September 3, 1937 - July 30, 2014

Betty B. Cokrill of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, July 30, 2014, at Chester River Hospital Center. She was 76.

Born on September 3, 1937, in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late William Earl and Nellie Pearl Gadd. Mrs. Cokrill graduated from Southern High School, Class of 1955. In her younger years, Mrs. Cokrill was a Barbizon model in Baltimore for several years prior to her paralegal career. She worked from 1963-1978 at Ober, Grimes, and Shriver Attorneys at law at the Maryland National Bank Building in Baltimore, MD, then worked for Amos I. Meyers Attorneys at law and later at Milton Talkin Attorney office.

Later in life, she worked as a receptionist for Upper Shore Aging, Inc., until 2004 and most recently with Amy Lynn Ferris Adult Activity Center in Chestertown where she participated in many Senior Center functions around the Chestertown and Easton areas. Mrs. Cokrill was Job's Daughter at Bethel Lodge #29 in Brooklyn, MD (Masonic Affiliation) where she was "Past Honored Queen." Mrs. Cokrill loved the Baltimore Orioles.

She is survived by a daughter, Allison S. Cokrill of Prattville, AL, and a grandson, Nicholas Dalton Messer of Prattville, AL.
