Betty Ann Coleman of Worton, MD, died Wednesday, December 28, 2016, at her home in Worton, surrounded by her family. She was 86.

Born May 28, 1930, in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of Albert and Grace Vansant. Mrs. Coleman was a 1947 graduate of Millington High School. Soon after graduating from high school, she married William Coleman and started their family together living on a dairy farm in Chesterville. In the mid 1950's, they moved to Chestertown, and then in 1989 moved to Worton.

Betty Ann was a member of Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church and a former member of the Ladies Auxiliary of Chestertown Volunteer Fire Company. She enjoyed flower gardening, going to the Crumpton Sale and craft shows, traveling to Pennsylvania to Lancaster and Longwood Gardens, and, most importantly, raising her family.
