



## Betty Lou Virginia Ferrier

January 3, 1942 - September 1, 2020

Betty Lou Virginia (Brower) Ferrier of Kent Island, MD, passed away at the age of 78 on September 1, 2020, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. She was 78.

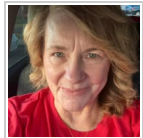
