



## Betty Ruth Hunter

February 1, 1928 - January 31, 2013

Betty Ruth Hunter of Chester, MD, died on January 31, 2013, at the Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Born on February 1, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Joseph H. Walker and Phoebe Middleton Walker Reynolds. Mrs. Hunter worked as a telephone operator for C&P Telephone, a position from which she retired in 1980 after 26 years of service.

Mrs. Hunter was an active member of Immanuel United Methodist Church, where she served as financial secretary for over 20 years, as well as being a member of the United Methodist Women and Bible study groups.
