January 21, 1929 - March 18, 2009

Betty Jane Dennis Gay of Easton, MD, died at the Memorial Hospital of Easton on Wednesday, March 18, 2009. She was 80.

Born in Denton, MD, on January, 21 1929, she was the daughter of the late John Wesley and Bessie Anna Corkran Dennis. During WWII, her father served as a flight instructor for the U.S. Army; during this time she lived and attended schools in Maryland, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Oklahoma.
