Betty McCormick Jones of Easton died Saturday, January 12, 2013 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, son and daughter-in-law at her side. She was 91. Born April 9, 1921 in Wilmington, DE to the late, Almira Macklem and Samuel McCormick.
