August 28, 1925 - January 22, 2015

Betty A. Kehr died on January 22, 2015 at Forest Hill Health and Rehabilitation Center in Forest Hill, MD. She was 89 years old.

Born on August 28, 1925 in Grasonville, MD to the late Alexander Thomas and Kasella Marshall Thomas. Betty attended Stevensville High School; graduating class of 1944. She began with the B&O Railroad, becoming a keypunch operator. On August 17, 1946 she married Glenn Lester Kehr, Sr. After retiring from the B&O in 1952 she became a mother and homemaker. In 1956 she moved to Stevensville where she resided until her death.

Betty is a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church, VFW Ladies Auxiliary, and was one of the charter members of the American Legion Ladies Auxiliary.

She is survived by two children, Glenn L. Kehr, Jr. and Kasella A. Zahn; five grandchildren, Brian Kehr, Kristopher Kehr, Cheryl Huff, Charles Nickerson, Jr. and Jimmy Zahn and seven great grandchildren. Betty was predeceased by her husband, Glenn L. Kehr, Sr.
