Betty Louise Pusey of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully at home at Bayleigh Chase on Thursday, June 15. She was 93.

Born on March 11, 1924, in Washington, DC, she was the daughter of the late Nelle Viola Walther Butt and Thomas Albert Butt. She grew up in Washington, DC, and graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School. She graduated from William and Mary College. She worked for a number of years as the branch manager of Bethesda Bank.
