CORDOVA: Betty Ann Councill of Cordova died Sunday, August 9, 2009 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 75.

Born on September 26, 1933 in the Cordova area of Talbot County, she was the daughter of the late C. Temple and Mabel Ewing Rhodes.
