Betty B. Denham died on July 22, 2001 at 7:30a.m. At Jackson General Madison County Hospital in Jackson, TN from complications due to a stroke.

She was the daughter of H. Elizabeth Burris and Mowbray Wesley Hadaway. She was born in Easton, MD on July 29, 1920 and raised in Worton, MD. Mrs. Denham was a 1936 graduate of Chestertown High School. After graduation she worked as a telephone operator from 1937-1942. She was active in Worton United Methodist Church acting as organist until moving family to Jacksonville, FL in 1957 where she was a member of the choir and substitute organist at the Trinity Methodist Church there.

In 1962, the family moved to Milan, TN where she worked in a fabric shop. In 1968, she married John Denham and moved to his home in Cambridge, OH taking her daughter Cindy with her. As grandchildren were active in the Methodist church choir and Milan High School band, she and her husband moved to Milan, TN in 1989 where they were active in the Methodist church.

Her hobbies were reading, writing letters and knitting.

Her husband, John, preceded her in death.

of Milan, TN and Cindy Brown Nagy of Crestline, OH; 1 sister Mrs. Mary Beulah Ziesel of Chestertown, MD 4 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.
