Beulah Mae Towers of Easton, MD, passed away on June 27, 2015 at Genesis, The Pines. She was 90.

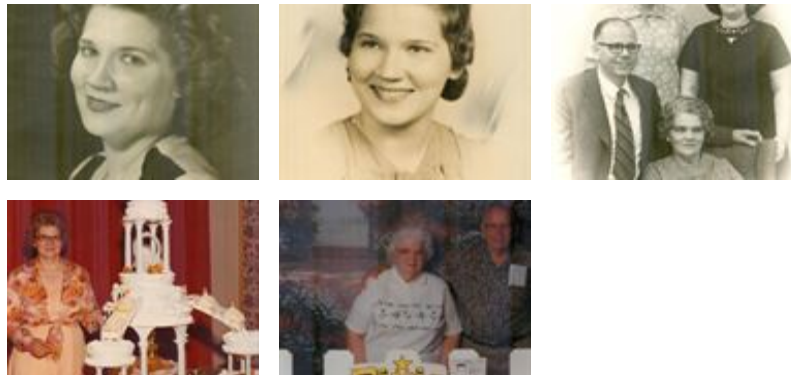
