



## Beverly Lynn Catterton

August 18, 1956 - October 1, 2012

Beverly Lynn Catterton, of Chester, MD, died on October 1, 2012, after a long illness, at the University of Maryland Medical Center. She was 56.

Born in Annapolis, MD, on August 18, 1956, she was the daughter of the late Robert F. Gibbons and Mary E. Ward. She grew up in Annapolis and attended Annapolis High School. Beverly married Ronald "Catfish" Catterton on June 12, 1976, and the couple made their home in Annapolis until 1984, when they moved to Chester, MD. Beverly spent her life making a loving home for her family.

Beverly's true passions in life were country music and caring for her family and friends. Her grandsons, Parker and Corbin, were her heart. She took pleasure in planning, decorating and catering for family gatherings. She loved attending her children's sporting events such as baseball, lacrosse, and soccer.
