Bill Foster of Cordova, MD, formerly of Annapolis, died on Wednesday, September 6, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 56.

Born March 13, 1950 in Annapolis, MD, he was the son of the late Samuel D., Jr. and Betty Ann Wheat Foster. He was a 1968 graduate of the Marine Military Academy in Harlingen, TX. For twenty years, Mr. Foster owned and operated the Pleasant Plains Turf Farm in Annapolis, and then moved to Cordova where he started the Chesapeake Sod Farm and the William H. Foster Trucking Company.

A charter member and one of the founders of the Severna Park Elks Club, he was an adopted member of the Easton Elks Club, Past President of the MD Turf Association, a member of the St. Andrews Society of the Eastern Shore and a member of numerous other associations.

Mr. Foster is survived by his wife, Joyce Foster, whom he married June 7, 1985; four children, William Hill Cocke Foster and his wife Evelyn of Texas, Thomas C. Tyler, Jr. and his wife Bridgette of Denton, Julia L. Schneberger and her husband Mark of Finksburg, and Alisa M. Tyler of Pasadena; a brother, Samuel D. Foster, III and his wife Deborah of Annapolis; two sisters, Helen Bradley Foster and her husband Fred Cooper of Minneapolis, MN and Terry Richetta; and three grandchildren, Thomas C. Tyler, III, Emma E.

Schneberger, and a special granddaughter whom he has raised since birth, Brittany M. Tyler of Cordova.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, September 14, 2006 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery, Cordova, MD.
