Billie B. Lloyd, long-time resident of the Eastern Shore, died Saturday, October 30, 2004. She was 83.

Born on June 8, 1921 in Fenton, IA, she was the daughter of the late, Dolores Dudley and Clarence Bryant Brooker. She graduated from Ames High School and attended Iowa State University. She began working for General Electric for the war effort in WWII where she met her husband, H. Richard Lloyd, Jr. They were married July 16, 1944 and resided in Schenectady, NY. Due to his career, they moved all over the U.S. until his retirement in 1984 when they settled on the Eastern Shore.

Billie was a member of the Alter Guild for St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Queenstown, MD and Past President of the Alter Guild for Christ Episcopal Church, Stevensville, MD, the Trinity Cathedral in Easton, MD and Grace Episcopal Church in Alexandria, VA. She was also a Queen Anne's County Adult Day Care Foundation Volunteer, member of P.E.O., the Red Hat Society as Queen Mother, Queen Anne's Garden Club, Prospect Bay Country Club and Prospect Bay Yacht Club.

Mrs. Lloyd is survived by two children, H. Richard Lloyd, III and Tracey L. Bellotti, both of Alexandria, VA and a brother, Clarence "Lucky" Bryant Brooker of Concord, CA.

Memorial services will be held on Friday, November 5, 2004 at 11AM in St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Queenstown, MD.

Interment will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
