May 26, 1918 - July 21, 2015

Blanche Barbara Williams (Chmiel), 97, of Easton, MD, passed away on July 21, 2015. Blanche was born in Wheeling, WV, on May 26, 1918, to the late Anthony and Catherine (Kobiela) Chmiel.

She attended St. Mary's High School, graduating in 1936. She continued her education at Franklin Nursing School in Pittsburgh, PA. She returned to Wheeling where she worked at King's Daughter's Nursery. She and her family moved to Baltimore in 1945 where she became a nanny. As a nanny, she traveled with the family to their home in Vermont where she met her husband, Richard S. Williams. They were married on October 17, 1947, and enjoyed 57 years together. After his passing, she moved to Easton to be closer to her daughter.

In addition to her husband, Blanche is preceded in death by her sister, Sister Mary Fidelia Chmiel, CSSF; her brothers, Harry, Vincent, Edward, and Joseph Chmiel; her son, Richard A. Williams; and her grandson, Timothy Williams.

Blanche is survived by her son, Donald E. Williams and wife Bonnie of Manchester, MD; her daughter, Nancy K. Glenn and husband Kenneth of Easton, MD; her daughter-in-law, Denise Williams of Greensboro, MD; grandchildren; and great-grandchildren, all of whom she loved dearly.
