Bobbie Jean Traylor of Millsboro, DE, died on May 2, 2020, at Autumn Lake Nursing Facility in Chestertown, MD. She was 88.

She was born in Virginia on April 1, 1932, the daughter of the late Robert E. and Ella Lanningham Lee. She was a graduate of Patterson High School in Baltimore, MD.
