Brenda Faye Bender of Federalsburg, MD, died June 17, 2018, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton, MD. She was 71.

Mrs. Bender was born February 9, 1947, in Lancaster, PA, the daughter of the late John Northeimer and Mildred Stoner Futer. She was a 1965 graduate of Solanco High School in Quarryville, PA. She married Mr. Raymond George Bender and the two spent 50 years together. 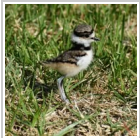
