Brenda Muriel Chrislip of Dover, DE, died Friday December 28, 2012, at Kent General Hospital in Dover, DE. She was 72.

Brenda M. Chrislip was born May 26, 1940, in Dover, DE, to the late Homer Turner and Alfreda "Archer." Mrs. Chrislip was a 1958 graduate of Sudlersville High School. After graduation she went to work for Stafford & Clements in Sudlersville, MD.

In 1968, she married her first husband, George Irwin, and lived in Smyrna, DE, and then moved to Daytona Beach, FL, a few years later. She returned to Delaware in 1988.

Brenda eventually went to work for Incorporating Services in Dover, DE, where she worked for several years before retiring. She was a member of Calvary Asbury Methodist Church in Sudlersville. After retirement, Brenda enjoyed working outside planting flowers, sitting at her pond, and making her yard beautiful. She also enjoyed cooking and spending time with her grandchildren and going "licking and riding" where she would take her grandkids to McDonalds for ice cream cones and then go for a ride in the car.

She was preceded in death by her first husband in 1988; her father, Homer Turner, in 1980; and her mother Alfreda Littleton on November 11, 2012.
