



Brenda Maude Walker

July 21, 1935 - July 12, 2014

Brenda M. Walker, died July 12, 2014, at Genesis at The Pines in Easton due to complications related to Alzheimer's. She was 78, and just a week short of her birthday. A longtime healthcare professional, she worked at The Pines in the 1970's as a licensed practical nurse, (LPN), and for many years at the Dixon House as well as a private sitter.

Born in the small town of Arlesey, England, north of London, daughter of the late Benjamin Richard Abbnett and Muriel Castle Abbnett, she lived through the German aerial bombings of World War II.

Brenda is best remembered for her love of all things iris. A long-time member of iris society groups and garden clubs, she won many ribbons for her prized flowers and arrangements. Her garden lives on with dozens and dozens of varieties. Other interests included anything British, the history of the Eastern Shore, and Maryland historical museums. She was also a prolific knitter and sewer of clothes. She even made outfits for her children's GI Joe dolls.

Proceeded in death by her son Martin J. Walker, she is survived by her beloved husband of 53 years, Finis O. Walker of Easton; one son, Jason J. Walker of Washington, DC; and two grandsons, Andy Walker-Bullock of Kirksville, MO, and James Walker-Bullock of Washington, DC. Brenda lived a rich and full life and will be greatly missed by her family and friends.

A funeral service will be held at Trinity Cathedral, 315 Goldsborough St., Easton, MD 21601 on Tuesday, July 15, 2014, at 10 a.m. Interment will follow in Springhill Cemetery.
