



## Brenda Egeberg Marzucco

March 20, 1957 - June 20, 2009

Brenda Marzucco of Stevensville, Maryland died Saturday, June 20, 2009 at her home. She was 52.

Born March 20, 1957 in Baltimore, Maryland, she was the daughter of the late, Rosaleen Sewell and Joseph Dewey Egeberg of Severna Park, Maryland. She graduated from Martin Spalding High School class of 1975 and Salisbury University with a degree in Political Science, class of 1979. Brenda worked 17 years at Chesapeake College, serving as the Youth Director for the Upper Shore Work Investment Board. Her mission was helping local youth to get jobs, keep jobs and learn the value of work. She was dedicated to giving youth guidance, life skills and prepare them for career opportunities to better their future. Thousands of local young people benefited from the passion that Brenda brought to her work.

Brenda's work was second only to the passion and love she held for her daughter Blake, one of her greatest life achievements.

Brenda leaves many friends that will always remember her for bringing humor to every situation in life. She also had a great passion for animals. Brenda had a great love for the arts, music in particular. She enjoyed her time at Flagler Beach in Florida.

Ms. Marzucco is survived by her loving daughter, Blake Marzucco of Charleston, SC, formerly of Stevensville, MD; sister, Leslie Adlam of San Diego, CA; two brothers, Thomas Egeberg of Easton, MD and Joseph Egeberg III of Ormond Beach, FL; and many nieces and nephews.
