Brian D. Hurd (Bro), 59, of Stevensville, MD passed away at Anne Arundel Medical Center on October 25, 2023.

Brian was born in Silver Spring, MD on April 29, 1964, the son of the late James Ernest Hurd (Ernie) and Judith Ann Craig Hurd (Judy). Brian attended South River High School and was a graduate of Mayo University with honors. He worked as a mechanic before the time he was even able to drive, then finishing his career with Queen Anne County.

Brian lived most of his life in Edgewater, MD, and Queenstown, MD. He had only recently moved back to Stevensville, MD. Brian was a fun-loving daredevil from the time he was little to the time he “grew up”. Bro drove a dirt track car, bungie jumped off the New River Gorge Bridge, white river rafted, sky dived, loved to fish and was an avid Hooters Restaurant patron. Because anywhere you went, a Hooters Restaurant had to be found for lunch or dinner! He was a huge NASCAR and NHRA fan and loved the Seattle Seahawks. An incredible storyteller, he was always ready to swap a story and share a laugh. Brian would be the first one to show up if you needed help, sometimes even way before the time you told him, as he did not want to be late. Brian thoroughly enjoyed going to many car shows, such as Carlisle PA, and showing his 1970 Dodge R/T Convertible.

Brian was one of the founding members of the Ridgley Car Show, which ran for 10 years and benefited the Petty Family Foundation and raising a significant amount for charity. He also helped with Petty Fest and the Petty

Museum, which he helped move back to its original location in Level Cross, NC. Brian was also one of the founders of the Pink Cares of the Eastern Shore, which directly assists cancer patients on the Eastern Shore.

Brian is preceded in death by his father, Ernie "Homer" Hurd. He is survived by his mother, Judy Hurd; brother, Kevin Hurd; brother, Dan (Caroline) Hurd; sister, Kelly (Wes) Hurd Whitelock; niece, Amanda (CJ) Hurd Germuth; nephew, Austin Hurd; nephew, Jacob Whitelock; great-nephews, Holden and Sullivan Germuth; and close family friends, Brenda Walls and Debbie and Joe Kadjeski.
