November 11, 1959 - June 19, 2018

Brian Edward Mitchell of Frederick, MD, passed away on June 19, 2018, at his home. He was 58.

Born in Virginia on November 11, 1959 to Edward F. Mitchell and the late Suzanne Sublett Mitchell, he grew up in Vienna, VA, and graduated from Oakton High School, Class of 1977. Brian studied at Elon College, Chesapeake College, and Florida Atlantic University. He held a number of jobs in Virginia and Maryland, including store manager at Ace Hardware in Stevensville from 2008 – 2011. Brian developed a passion for photography early on and this skill, along with his outgoing and jovial personality, served him well both personally and professionally throughout his life.

In addition to his father, Edward Mitchell of Stevensville, MD, Brian is survived by his sister, Karen Mitchell; nieces, Stephanie Holland and Caroline Strojny (Brian); great niece Cameron; and great-nephew Nathan.

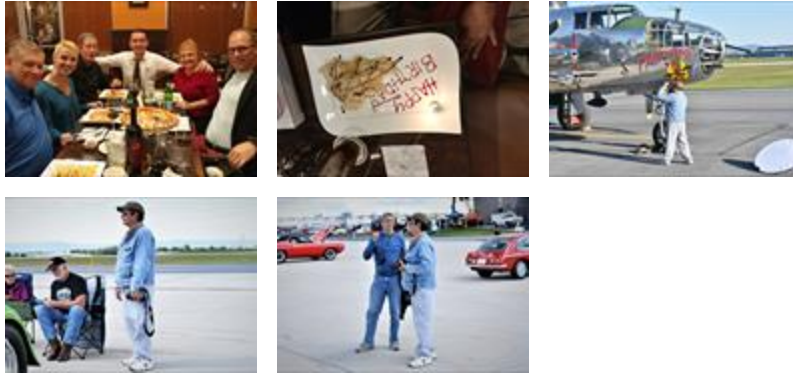

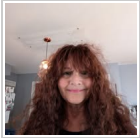

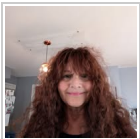
