



Bruce Maxwell

October 5, 1941 - August 10, 2009

Bruce L. Maxwell of Chestertown, MD, passed away with his wife by his side on August 10, 2009, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown. He was 67.

He was born in White Plains, NY, and raised at Worton Manor by his great-grandmother Nora Maxwell and his grandparents the late Jesse and Mrs. Grace Maxwell. He was most proud of the fact that his great grandfather, Jonathan Dixon Maxwell, was a noted automobile inventor and president of Maxwell-Briscoe Company in the early 1900's.

Bruce worked as waterman, keeping his boat at Kibler's Marina, he crabbed and fished the Chester River and the Chesapeake Bay. He retired from his career as a waterman and purchased a 1923 Maxwell two door Sedan which he proudly drove around Chestertown. Bruce could fix almost anything, he enjoyed helping others, old time rock-n-roll, motorcycling with his friends and spending time with his family. He was a member of the Antique Automobile Club of America and a past member of the Maryland Waterman's Association.

He is survived by his wife, whom he married on December 7, 1984, Cathy Moore Maxwell; a daughter, Kimberly Ann Ewell and her husband Rusty of East New Market, MD; a son, Daniel Lee Maxwell of Fruitland, MD; grandchildren, Kara Elizabeth Ewell and Joseph William Russell Ewell of East

New Market, MD; a sister, Mary A. Hollingsworth of France. One brother, the late George Daniel Maxwell, predeceased him.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday August 15, 2009, at 3:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 408 South Liberty Street, Centreville, MD, where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to the service (2:00 – 3:00). Interment will be in Chesterfield Cemetery, Centreville.
