Bruce Milton Carroll, of Easton, MD, died at his home in Easton on Thursday, May 23, 2002. He was 51.

Born in Easton, December 16, 1950, he was the son of the late Milton Thomas and Jeanette Slaughter Carroll. After graduating from Easton High School in 1969, he later attended Chesapeake College where he received his Associates Degree in Architectural Drafting. Following his high school graduation, he worked in auto body repair until serving in the U. S. Army from 1970 until 1971. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Easton to work in the family business, Carroll Floor Service. Following its sale, he started his own floor service then began work as a general contractor. He was also a partner in a local restaurant for a short period of time.

A resident of Easton for the majority of his life, he had been active in the local softball leagues.

Survivors include a brother, Brent T. Carroll and his wife, Linda, of Centreville, MD, and a niece, Courtney L. Carroll of Royersford, PA.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, May 29, at 10 AM at the MD Veterans Cemetery – Eastern Shore Chapel near Hurlock. Burial will follow in the cemetery.
