



Bryan Kurt Hubbard

October 24, 1952 - August 29, 2008

Bryan Kurt Hubbard of Barclay, MD died suddenly at Hospice House, Centreville, MD surrounded by his family and friends due to complications from multiple strokes. He was 55.

Born October 24, 1952 in Dundalk, MD, he was the son of Charlotte Foote Hubbard and the late, John H. Hubbard. He graduated from Dundalk High School, Class of 1970. He served in the U.S. Marines during Vietnam War and was medically retired. He returned to Dundalk where he began his career in trucking and warehousing until 1990 when he established Transportation Systems Inc. in Baltimore. He later sold this and began Commercial Carpet Logistics of Stevensville, MD. .

Bryan enjoyed hunting, fishing, boating, singing karaoke and being with his family.

In addition to his mother, Bryan is survived by is wife, Madeline P. Hubbard; a son, Todd Hubbard of Stevensville, MD; a daughter, Michelle Schimpler and her husband, Matthew of Dundalk, MD; a sister, Karen Taylor of Smyrna, DE; brother, John Hubbard of Smyrna, DE; step-daughter, Dawn Coursey and Stoney May of Chestertown, and step-son, Chris Coursey and his wife, Maggie of Church Hill, MD and seven grandchildren, William, Dane, Chelsea, Abigail, Joshua, Cole and Alex.

Private graveside service for family and friends will be held at Cedar Hill Cemetery, Baltimore, MD on Friday, September 5, 2008 at 11:00 AM.

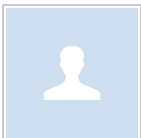
