



## Byron Jonathan Dill Jr.

April 26, 1928 - January 22, 2018

Byron Jonathan Dill, Jr. of Chestertown, MD, passed to his rest on Monday, January 22, 2018. He was 89.

Byron was born in Snow Hill, MD, on April 26, 1928, the son of the late Byron Dill and Mary Tabitha Melson. Following his graduation from Snow Hill High School in 1946, he attended trade school. He later graduated from Prince George's Community College with a degree in computer technology.

Byron served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War from 1950-52 and was honorably discharged. He returned home, but his adventurous spirit led him to work for NASA as a service manager and for Pan Am. He was also self-employed as a mechanic and truck driver until his retirement in 1992.

As a long-haul truck driver, he loved being on the road and crisscrossed the U.S. countless times. As a model train enthusiast, he loved collecting while on the road and working on his trains when at home.

Byron was a member of the Chestertown Seventh-day Adventist Church and served as head elder for 10 years. For many years, he led out in the community services food program and the fruit program.

Byron was a constant friend, a devoted husband, and a loving father. He is

survived by his wife, Helen Hill Dill, his high school sweetheart, whom he finally married on October 27, 1991, after they were newly reunited. Better late than never.

Byron is also survived by his children from his first marriage to Susan Keppler: a daughter, Cynthia Dill Cephas (Montre) of Mardela Springs, MD; two sons, Byron Jonathan Dill III (Beth) of Amarillo, TX, and David Allen Dill (Jennifer) of Auburn, WA; stepsons, Frank Spina and Vincent Spina; grandchildren, Whitney Dill Burnett, Austin White, Brandon Dill, Jessica Dill, Juliana Dill, and Maureen Kelley Spina; and great-grandchildren, Kendall White and Austin White, Jr.

Services will be held on Sunday, January 28, 2018, at 11:00 AM, at the Chestertown SDA Church, where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to the service. Interment will be held on Monday, January 29, at 11 AM, at Maryland Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.

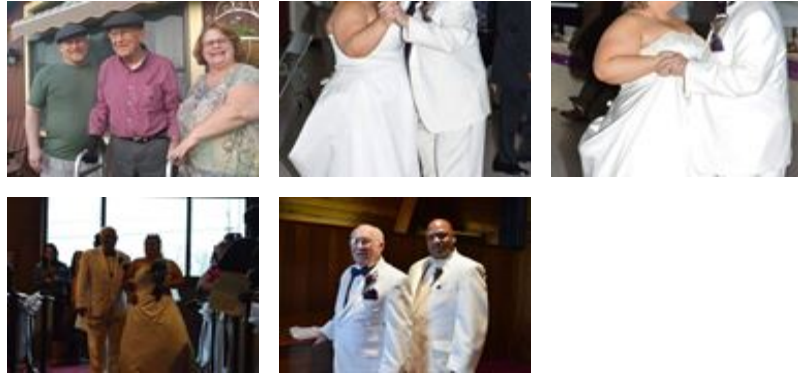

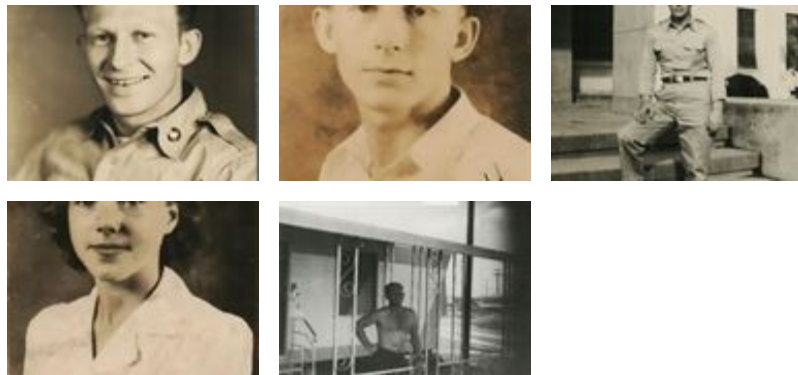
