

Calvin Clifton Embert

January 24, 1940 - April 24, 2025

Calvin Clifton Embert of Sudlersville, MD passed away on Thursday, April 24, 2025 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 85.

Calvin Clifton Embert was born Jan 24, 1940, in Sudlersville, MD the son of the late Frank Embert Sr. and Lola "Alexander". He graduated from Sudlersville High School in 1957 and then enlisted in the U.S. Army and served for 6 years. After an honorable discharge he went to work as a Sawyer for E.E. Pierce for 33 years. He then went to work for Frannie Schaubert where he sawed the lumber used to restore the U.S. Constellation. He then began farming locally with Eric Panerie for about 15 years. His driving career began with Alger Oil as a transport driver and after 9 years he changed over to driving a bus and was self-contracted by Queen Anne's County for 22 years. Calvin also spent his Saturday's working for the town of Sudlersville for over 20 years. He was a lifetime member of Holdens Chapel Church where he taught adult Sunday School, served on the board and was the caretaker/janitor for 60 years. He served as the superintendent for Lebonon Church for 18 years and taught Sunday school. Calvin enjoyed junking on the weekend with Clifton, working in his garden growing pole beans, tomatoes and corn, playing softball up to age 38, trips to Lancaster, PA and making pizzas at Deb's on Friday and Saturday nights.

In addition to his parent's, he was preceded in death by his son Mikey Embert, brothers, Frank Embert Jr., Clifton Embert and sisters, Dorothy, Emma, Catherine, Frances and Margaret.

He is survived by his wife of 66 years, Marian "Bets" Embert of Sudlersville, MD, three daughters, Sandy, Debbie (Lenny), Melissa (Robbie), four grandchildren, Crystal, Monica, Gretchen and Abby, three great grandchildren, Tyler, Jaxon and Sophia and two brothers, William and Daniel.

A visitation will be held Saturday, May 3, 2025, from 5- 8pm at Fellows Family Funeral Home 370 Cypress St. Millington, MD. A service will be held Sunday, May 4, 2025, at 2pm also at the funeral home. Burial will follow the service in Sudlersville Cemetery.

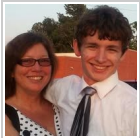
