



Calvin Albert Frazier

January 28, 1931 - January 5, 2024

Calvin Albert Frazier was called to his Heavenly home on January 5, 2024, at the age of ninety-two. Calvin was born in Chestertown, Maryland on January 28, 1931, the son of Lula Catherine and James Earl Frazier who both preceded him in death. He graduated from Henry Highland Garnett High School with the class of 1949. In high school, he worked as a barber in town and continued to pursue this career by going to Barber School where he got his certification. He attended college at Princess Anne before enlisting in the United States Army, from which he was given a medical discharge. After his time in the Army, he returned to Chestertown and opened Frazier's Hunter's Bar while also working as a fabric inspector for Dupont in Delaware.

Calvin was a dedicated member of Janes UMC and worked in many capacities. Calvin was a great storyteller. He was the historian of the Frazier Family. He knew everyone in Chestertown, and according to him most of the folks were his cousins. He was an avid hunter, a long-time commander in the local American Legion, Frank M. Jarman American Legion in Chestertown and a member of the Masons. (Prince Hall Affiliated). He was highly active in local Chestertown history and Civil War reenactments. His name is even engraved on a local statue for his work in getting the statue placed in Chestertown.

In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by his wife, Alberta Frazier; son, Charles A. Frazier, Sr.; brother, James Frazier; and sister, Rosanna Fletcher. Calvin is survived by his children: Ronald Frazier of Chesapeake, VA; Arwilla Broadnax, Calvin LaRue (Charlene); Michael LaRue of Delaware; Jedina

Frazier; one brother: Wilbur Frazier of Phila. PA; One sister: Marjorie Shelton of Fairmount Heights, MD; his grandchildren and great-grandchildren; as well as many nieces, nephews and cousins.

Services will be held on Thursday, January 25 at 12:00 pm at Jane's United Methodist Church in Chestertown. A viewing will be held two hours prior, from 10:00 am - 12:00 pm. Interment will be held at a later date at the Eastern Shore Veteran's Cemetery.

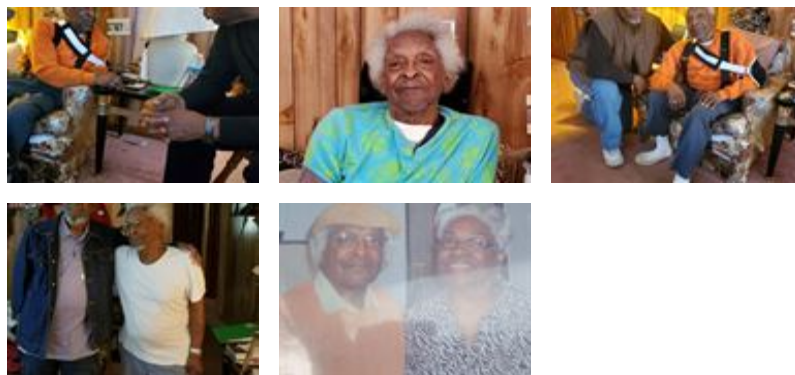
