



Calvin Charles Hartigan

July 16, 1939 - February 1, 2026

Calvin Charles Hartigan passed away suddenly at his home in Chestertown, MD on February 1, 2026. He was 86 years old.

Calvin was born on July 16, 1939 in Philadelphia, PA, the son of the late Harold Willard Hartigan and Ida Marie Hartigan. He was a graduate of Northeast High School with the class of 1957, and briefly studied at Temple University as well. He enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he was stationed in Labrador, Greenland working as a transporter. He was honorably discharged after two and a half years of service, and was very proud of his time with the Air Force.

He worked the majority of his career with First Pennsylvania Bank in Philadelphia, PA. In 1977, he moved his family to Chestertown, commuting to work at the bank in Philadelphia until the 90s. He then worked for Wisco Envelope, and then Heron Point before retiring in 2010.

In addition to his loving wife of nearly 60 years, Judith, he is survived by his daughters, Karen "Beth" Kendall (and the late Dave Kendall) and Kathryn "Kathy" Pratt (Bill); his grandchildren, Mason Reed, Sr. (Amber), Zakary "Zak" Kendall, and Kailee Reed; as well as two great-grandchildren, Mason Reed, Jr. and Evelyn Reed.

Services will be held on Thursday, February 12 at 12:00 pm at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home in Chestertown. A viewing will be held one hour prior, from 11:00 am – 12:00 pm at the funeral home. Interment to follow at Crumpton Cemetery.
