Calvin O. Yowell, Jr passed away comfortably at his home in Easton, MD on August 30, 2026. He was a 30-year survivor of stage 4 non-Hodgkin's lymphoma cancer, and courageously rallied against congestive heart failure (CHF), and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).
