Carl A. Dahlbom, 93, died September 27, 2005 at home with his family.

Born in Brooklyn, New York, he received his B.E.E. (Bachelor of Electrical Engineering) from Polytechnic Institute of New York and joined the Bell Laboratories in 1933 and devoted his entire career there, concentrating on planning both domestic and international telecommunications systems and was a U.S. representative to a worldwide committee for this purpose. Mr. Dahlbom published numerous papers on his work and held seven patents. After retirement, he served as a consultant for Bell Labs (AT&T).

Mr. Dahlbom spent eleven years living in Greenlawn, New York where he served on the Harborfields School Board and treasurer of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. Moving to Colts Neck, New Jersey in 1962, he served on the local planning board and on the zoning board and as treasurer of Colts Neck Reformed Church for 16 years.

Mr. Dahlbom and his wife, Dorothy, moved to Heron Point in 1996 and joined the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown.

Mr. Dahlbom is survived by his wife of 65 years, Dorothy, and a daughter, Carol Hagert of Annapolis, and grandchildren, Christopher Hagert of and Kristin Hagert, and Eric Dahlbom and David Dahlbom of Waltham, Massachusetts. His son, Alan, predeceased him in 2004.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, October 1st at Wesley Hall in Heron Point.
