Carl Anthony Goetz, 77, of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, March 6, 2013, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. Mr. Goetz was born in Portland, OR, on August 10, 1935. He was the son of the late Peter P. Goetz and Ann M. Gaffrey Goetz.

Mr. Goetz served in the United States Navy from 1955-1959. He settled in Maryland after his service where he worked as a refrigeration technician. He was employed with MEBA Engineering for several years and also worked for Johnson Controls. He later retired and worked with the Talbot County Library where he developed many lifelong friendships. He was a 50-year member of Saints Peter and Paul Parish, serving as an usher in recent years. Carl enjoyed spending his time with family and loved ones and helping those in need.

He is survived by two daughters, Heather J. Wright and her husband, Jim of Sudlersville, and April Goetz of Greensboro; two brothers, Jerry Goetz of Palm Desert, CA, and Robert Goetz of Billings, MT; two sisters, Kathy Goetz, and Eileen Peterson, both of Fargo, ND; three grandchildren, Aaron Lewis, Jessica Clough, and Hannah Wright; and several nieces and nephews.
