Carl Haass of Stevensville, MD died Tuesday, October 21, 2003 at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 91.

Born on July 18, 1912 in Marydel, DE, he was the son of the late Richard and Mary Stoefl Haass. Carl attended school in Hartley, DE. On October 16, 1935, he married Emily Usilton Haass of Greensboro, MD and they resided in Wilmington, DE where Carl was an equipment operator. In 1952, he co-owned and operated Parreco and Haass Excavation in Washington, D.C. and in December 1971, they relocated to Stevensville, MD. A few years later in 1977, he opened Haass and Broyles Excavation with his son-in-law. During his career, he excavated thousands of Washington sites including the Vietnam Memorial in Washington, D.C.

He was a member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church and an active member of the men's prayer breakfast. Carl was a game fisherman and enjoyed boating. He also enjoyed gardening, crabbing, collecting, making clocks, playing games and especially spending time with his family.

In addition to his loving wife Emily, Carl is survived by one daughter, Betty Broyles and her husband, David of University Park, MD; one brother, Frederick H. Haass of Kingsville, TX; four grandchildren, Carla Atchison and her husband, Don of Davidsonville, MD, Beth Clarke and her husband, Jim of

Cary, NC, Lydia French and her husband, Larry of Stevensville, MD and Valerie Chick and her husband, Chris of Edgewater, MD and thirteen great grandchildren.
