Carl Campbell Longmire, Sr. of Crumpton, MD, formerly of Front Royal, Virginia died on October 14, 2004 at University of Maryland Hospital Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 70.

Born in Dinwiddie, Virginia on November 14, 1933, he was the son of the late Ira W. Longmire and Ella Mae L. Stillwell.

Mr. Longmire was a graduate of Thomasdale High School Class of 1950 in Chester, Virginia. He then enlisted in the United States Army and served during the Korean Conflict with the Army Paratroopers. He was honorably discharged in 1952. He returned to Sykesville, Maryland where he worked as a power lineman with Baltimore Gas & Electric for 30 years then with Philadelphia Electric & Power in Elkton, Maryland for 11 years. He retired in 1993.

In 1982 he married the former, Betsy Ann Vollmerhausen. They enjoyed traveling until 1997, when they returned to the Eastern Shore. He enjoyed fishing, traveling and cruising.

He was a Life Member of F.M.J. American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown, Maryland, a member of Trinity Lutheran Church and of C.R.A.B.'s (Chester River Advocates for Blind Services).

Mr. Longmire is survived by his wife, Betsy Ann Longmire; one sister, Lucille

Ames of Shreveport, Louisiana; four sons, Carl C. Longmire and Michael L. Longmire, both of Front Royal, Virginia, William H. Longmire of Chester Gap, Virginia, William Ricketts of Chestertown, Maryland and four daughters, Denise A. Langis of Front Royal, Virginia, Michelle Kenney of Richmond, Virginia, Dawn Lisa McCoy of Conway, South Carolina, and Robin L. Paulic of Virginia Beach, Virginia. He was preceded in death by one sister, Helen Chrobot and one brother, James Longmire.
