Carl Leonard Moore of Long Point in Earleville, MD died on August 31, 2003 at his home. He was 88.

Born in Bryn Mawr, PA on February 19, 1915, he was the son of the late Frank and Helen Printz Moore.

Mr. Moore was educated in the Lower Marion School System. He married Mildred Dolores Kolterman and in 1941 enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He served on the U.S.S. Midway during WWII as an aviation mechanic. Upon his honorable discharge in 1945 he returned to the Philadelphia area and worked as an auto mechanic and service station operator. He retired in 1980 and moved to Long Point in Earleville, MD. There he enjoyed many years of hunting, fishing and boating. Mrs. Moore died on June 13, 2003.

Mr. Moore was a member of the Zion United Methodist Church in Cecilton, MD, the Cecil County Senior Citizens and he was a past member of the King of Prussia Vol. Fire Department where he served 20 years.

Mr. Moore is survived by a daughter, Susan Dodd of Duluth, GA; two grandchildren, Rebecca Sherlock and Gregory Dodd, both of Atlanta, GA; a great grandson, Ethan Michael Sherlock of Atlanta, GA and nine siblings.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, September 6, 2003 at 11:00 A.M. at Zion United Methodist Church in Cecilton, MD. The Rev. Joseph Burris will officiate.

Interment will be held privately.
