Carl Orr of Chestertown died in his home on December 7, 2004. He was 88.

Born on October 30, 1916 in Rock Hall, Maryland, he was the son of the late George Price and Otilia Schmidt Orr. He graduated from Rock Hall High School, Class of 1933. He was employed with Great Atlantic and Pacific Tea Company in Elkton and Chestertown from 1933 to 1942. He married Louise Wright on April 22, 1943. Mr. Orr served in the United States Army from 1942 to 1946 when he was honorably discharged as a Corporal. He had served during World War II in Central Europe. After returning to Chestertown, he began his career with C&P Telephone Company, where he worked as a field engineer for over 30 years, until his retirement in 1980. His wife predeceased him in 1995.

He was a devoted member of Christ United Methodist Church where he was very involved and well loved. He was also a devoted member of Chestertown Volunteer Fire Department for over 50 years. He was a past Master of Chester Lodge #115 A.F. & A.M., a member of the Boumi Temple, Telephone Pioneers and the Frank M. Jarmen American Legion Post #36 of Chestertown. Mr. Orr was a good and faithful servant to his family, church and community.

Mr. Orr is survived by one daughter, Peggy O. Tracy and her husband, Steve of Newark, Delaware; one son, Robert C. Orr and his wife, Karen of Easton,

Maryland; five grandchildren, Jessica McCracken and her husband, Tom of Trappe, Maryland, Jonathan Tracy and Lauren Tracy of Newark, Delaware, and Gaets Orr and Leeds Orr of Easton. Mr. Orr is also survived by a devoted friend, Kitty Gsell of Chestertown, Maryland.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, December 11, 2004 at Christ United Methodist Church in Chestertown, Maryland at 11:00 a.m.
