



## Carl L. Pusey Jr.

Carl Long Pusey, Jr. of Easton, MD died on Tuesday, December 18, 2007 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 88.

Born July 13, 1919 in Cape Charles, VA, he was the son of the late Carl L., Sr. and Lula Gambrill Pusey. After graduating from Wicomico High School in 1936, he attended Salisbury State College from 1936 until 1938 and Randolph Macon College in 1939. In 1941 he entered the U.S. Army during World War II and served in the 15th and 16th Calvary Regiment and overseas in the 36th Calvary Recon Troup. He was awarded five battle stars, a bronze star and one arrowhead. Following his release from active duty in 1946, he became involved in minor league baseball as the business manager for the Danville Leafs, The Lincoln Athletics and the Fayetteville A's. In 1947 he married the former Frances "Betsy" Fulton and she traveled with him in the minor leagues until 1953. After moving to Easton in 1958, he worked as the last station agent for the Pennsylvania Railroad serving the Easton area. He then worked for 13 years as a purchaser for Bayshore Foods, including when it was formerly J. McKenney Willis & Son.

He was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Kiwanis, V.F.W. #5246 and was involved with the Easton Little League as coach, umpire and President of the league for three separate terms.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Pusey is survived by a son, Carl L. Pusey, III of Middlebury, IN; a daughter, Susan Divilio of Easton; a sister, Bette Distler of Salisbury and five grandchildren, Brandon Pusey, Tara Seppa, and Chris, Dan, and Frank Divilio.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, December 21, 2007 at 2:00 PM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton, MD. Friends may call on Thursday evening from 6 to 8 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, Easton.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
