Carlos Manuel Vasquez died Saturday, November 26, 2011, as a result of a motor vehicle accident. He was 20.

Carlos was born July 27, 1991, in El Salvador, the son of Victor Manuel Vasquez Pena and Esmeralda Marisol Roque Alfaro. Carlos moved to the United States in February of 2000. He was a 2009 graduate of Kent County High School. He then went on and attended two years at Chesapeake Community College with the goal of joining the Sheriff's department K-9 unit. Mr. Vasquez worked for Moon Nursery, Roseland Nursery, and Anthony's Landscaping. He enjoyed playing soccer, hanging out with his friends, keeping his car spotless, and he was a huge fan of the Dallas Cowboys.

He is survived by his mother, Esmeralda Marisol Torres of Galena, MD; father, Carlos Torres of Galena, MD; two sisters, Eliza "Horsey" Mendoza of Galena, MD; Nasareth "Little Monkey" Mendoza of Galena, MD; five brothers; maternal grandparents, Elisa Alfaro and Carlos Roque; his girlfriend, Tavita Osario of Chestertown, MD; and godfather, Jesus Merino of El Salvador.
