



## Carlton N. Callahan

December 21, 1924 - November 23, 2014

Carlton N. Callahan died peacefully on November 23, 2014, at Genesis HealthCare, The Pines in Easton. He was 89.

Born December 21, 1924, in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late Alton Callahan and Margaret Favinger Callahan.

Carlton graduated from Easton High School in 1942 and had a lifelong career in farming. He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church. He was also a member of the Talbot County Council from 1986-1990 and Orphan's Court from 1982-1986 and 1990- 1994. Carlton was former vice president of the Talbot County Farm Bureau and a member of the Farmers Committee for Talbot County Agriculture and Stabilization for 15 years. He was also a former member of the Easton Ruritan Club and Easton Elks.

He is survived by, a sister, Rita C. Callaway of Carmichael/Queenstown, MD; and two nephews, Michael Callahan of Richmond, VA, and Lee Callaway of Centreville, MD; and one niece, Mollie Scharnus of Chester, MD. He was predeceased by his wife, Virginia Walls Boise Callahan; two brothers, Hazel Eugene Callahan of Easton/Longwoods and Jack Callahan of Longwoods.

A Funeral Liturgy will be held on Friday, November 28, 2014, at 10:30 a.m. at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton. Burial will follow at Woodlawn

Memorial Park.
