Carlton Lee Whaley passed away on February 6, 2021, surrounded by his wife and three children.

Carlton was born February 3, 1936, at Easton Memorial Hospital to John Richard McQuay Whaley and Rachael Mandrell Whaley. In that maternity ward, there was also a little baby girl that would one day be his wife. Carlton grew up on the family farm near Wye Island. He graduated from Queen Anne's County High School and the University of Maryland with a degree in Agriculture.

In 1958, he married his high school sweetheart; Pauline Bartlett Roe (Polly), and they moved to Easton where he started a 50+ year career in the poultry industry, first with J. McKinney Willis and Sons, Bayshore Foods, Kane-Miller, Country Pride and ConAgra before leaving for Cargill. He spent the last ten years of his working career successfully selling poultry breeder stock throughout the Mid-Atlantic region for Ross Breeders and Avigen.

His children said their father was always there for them and taught

them the value of family, friends, hard work, and love for their community. He will certainly be missed by all.
