



## Carlton A. Marvel Jr.

Carlton A. "Pete" Marvel. Jr. of Sugarmill Woods, Homosassa, FL, formerly of Easton, died at his home on Monday, November 1, 2004. He was 79.

Born in Ridgely, MD, September 7, 1925, he was the son of the late Carlton A., Sr. and Mary Elise Porter Marvel. After graduating from Ridgely High School and attending Drexel Institute, he served in the U. S. Navy during World War II as a radio gunner on dive bombers aboard the Aircraft Carrier USS Boxer. Following his release from active duty, he lived in Frederick, MD where he worked in soft drink distribution business and, later, as an agent for Metropolitan Insurance. In 1960, he moved to Easton where he was an agent for Nationwide Insurance until retiring in 1989.

While living in Easton, he was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, the Easton Lions Club, Easton Elks Lodge #1622 and the Talbot Country Club.

After moving to Homosassa in 1994, he was a member of the Homosassa United Methodist Church and the Sugarmill Woods Men's Golf Association.

Mr. Marvel is survived by his wife, the former Carolyn Taylor whom he married June 23, 1949; a daughter, Cathy Marvel, of Easton; three sons, Carlton A. "Skip" Marvel, III and his wife, Patricia, Keith D. Marvel and Bruce D. Marvel

and his wife, Lisa, all of Easton; a sister, Beverly Ray and her husband, Richard of Leesburg, FL; eleven grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren and one great-great grandchild.

Memorial services will be held on Tuesday, November 9th, at 4 P.M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to service.

Private burial will be at the Maryland Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
