



Carmelo DiPietro

January 7, 1926 - February 2, 2012

Carmelo DiPietro of Stevensville, MD, died on February 2, 2012, at the Queen Anne's Emergency Center. He was 86.

Born in New York City's Lower East Side on January 7, 1926, Mr. DiPietro was one of the nine children of the late Biagio and Virginia Portelli DiPietro. He went to school in Brooklyn, where he received a war diploma as he was drafted directly out of high school. He served in Japan as part of the occupation force. After completing his service, he married the former Elizabeth Hawley on June 30, 1946. They resided in Perryville, MD. Later, they moved to Takoma Park, MD, where Mr. DiPietro worked in the publishing industry as a bookbinder for Review and Herald Publishing Association in Washington, DC, and, later, for the Government Publishing Office. Mr DiPietro retired in 1996 and moved to Stevensville.

Mr. DiPietro enjoyed woodworking and was known as "Mr. Fixit" for his talent for home improvements. He was a member of the Grasonville Seventh-day Adventist Church.

He is survived by his loving wife, Elizabeth Leota Hawley DiPietro; his children, Gloria Mansfield (William) of Queenstown, Darlene Vernon (Lorne) of Stevensville, and Ken DiPietro (Joanne) of Stevensville; a sister, Josephine DiMaria; his grandchildren, Kevin Vernon (Aleksandra), Michael DiPietro, John

Mansfield, James Mansfield (Lauren) and Anne Marie Kreutzer; and great-grandchildren, Roman Vernon, Dustin Mansfield, Lane Mansfield, Clare Elaine Reams, and Grayson Lorne Reams.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, February, 7 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, where friends may call on Monday, February 6 from 6-8 p.m.

Burial will follow at the Crownsville Veterans Cemetery.
