



## Carmen A. Serrano

Carmen A. Serrano of Easton, MD, died Tuesday, October 2, 2001, at the University of Maryland Hospital in Baltimore from complications after open-heart surgery. He was 79.

Born January 6, 1922, he was the son of the late Carmine and Maria Gerace Serrano. He attended school in Baltimore and was a veteran of the United States Army. He served as a member of the original Darby's Rangers and was an instructor during World War II. He was employed by General Motors and in 1952. He designed and developed a Battery Support Assembly that was released for mass production by General Motors. The basic design is still used today. He then worked for a number of years as a salesman in the Mid-Atlantic region. An entrepreneur, he owned and operated several businesses in the area including Carmens Restaurant, Bay Country Bakery in Cambridge, and Trappe Station Country Store. He had many interests over his lifetime, including traveling, carpentry, boating, fishing and cooking. He wrote two books,

"Cooking With Wine Maryland's Eastern Shore Style" and "Devine Gems". He was a member of American Legion Post #70.

Mr. Serrano is survived by his wife, the former Caroline Russo, whom he married on March 4, 1977; three children, Daniel Serrano of Conowingo, MD, Joyce Melanson of Ontario, CA, and Regina Serrano of Ridgecrest, CA; three

step-children, Mark Campbell of Pittsville, MD, Jo Ann Campbell of Ocean City, MD and Laura Kelley of Oxford, MD; three grandchildren, Andrea Taylor, Danielle Higdon and Daniel Wilkes; two step-grandchildren, Nicholas Campbell and Benjamin Kelley and one great grandson, Brandon Taylor; a sister, Mary Mason of Easton, MD; a niece, Clare Ann Mason and two nephews, Frank Mason and Matthew Mason.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, October 6, 2001, at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
