



Carmen Marceau

April 1, 1934 - February 28, 2018

Carmen Marie Marceau of Easton, MD, lost her battle with Alzheimer's at her home on Wednesday, February 28, 2018, with her loving family by her side. She was 83.

Carmen was born in Granada, Spain, on April 1, 1934, to parents Fernando Quintana Pancordo and Carmen Morales Souza. Carmen attended the University of Granada in Spain, where she earned a degree in Nursing. She was a nurse and the administrator of three departments at Prince George's Hospital. Carmen worked diligently to have four grants passed with the Governor for the Department of Aging. On December 28, 1956, Carmen married Richard Marceau, and they made their home in Gambrills, MD. After 29 years, they relocated to Easton.

Carmen was a proud volunteer at Easton Memorial Hospital, a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Odenton, MD, and a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton.

Carmen is survived by her husband, Richard; their daughter, Natalia Spurry and her husband, Mike; two grandchildren, Matthew Coyle and Hazel Spurry; three step-grandchildren; and many step-great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents.
