Carol Ann Richter, 53, died Wednesday August 9, 2000, after complications from a long struggle with pulmonary hypertension. While awaiting a double-lung transplant, Carol fought for insurance and regulatory reform and became involved in organ transplant research.

Born in Baltimore, Carol lived with her family in Chicago and Pennsylvania before settling on Kent Island. She enjoyed spending time with her family, playing tennis, reading, dancing, cooking, and entertaining, especially at Christmas. She never missed an Orioles game, and she never passed up a chance to sit by the pool or to read a book on the beach.

Carol is survived by her husband, Brian, of 34 years; her son, Matthew, of Earlville, PA; her daughter, Amy Reilly of Churchton, MD; her brother, Michael of Old Lyme, CT; and her two grandchildren, Jackson and Patrick.

Family will receive friends and neighbors at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD, on August 11, 2000, from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. A funeral Mass will be held at St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester, MD.
