



Carol Miller Loveless

June 29, 1941 - December 9, 2015

Carol Miller Loveless, 74, passed away at her home in Easton, MD on December 9, 2015. Born June 29, 1941 in Baltimore, Maryland, she was the daughter of the late Donald and Eleanor Miller.

Carol served for 35 years in the Caroline County school system as a beloved elementary school teacher. She graduated from Baltimore's Eastern High School in 1959, where she was class president, attended Frostburg State Teachers College to then finish and receive her Bachelor's degree from Towson State University in 1963.

After graduating from Towson State, she moved with her husband to Preston and soon began teaching at Federalsburg Elementary. In 1971, she became a First grade teacher at Denton Elementary where she served out her career finishing as a teacher of Second Grade. Her selfless dedication and commitment to helping children develop a passion for learning was a hallmark characteristic that endeared her to generations of students.

In addition to being a working mother, she volunteered in the community through the years as a Girl Scout Leader and Band Parent. Upon retirement she became a domestic abuse counselor at Four All Seasons, member of Stephen Ministries, member of several church choirs, an after-school tutor, and an art instructor at various senior communities and at Brookletts Place –

Talbot County Senior Center.

She is survived by her daughter Donna Warner (Scott) of Easton MD, son Joseph S. Loveless III (Tina) of Purcellville VA, five grandchildren Joseph IV, Johnathan, Brittany, Julie and Brian, and two great-grandchildren Chloe and Joseph V; her brother Donald and his wife Su, nieces Jen Smith (Greg) of Spring Grove PA, and Kristy Wheeler (Mark) of Tallahassee FL and their children,.

A memorial service will be held on Tuesday, December 15 at 4pm at Grace Lutheran Church, 111 Brookletts Ave, Easton, MD 21601. Burial will be private.
