Carol Joyce (Schulz) Sappington of Annapolis, MD passed away on December 17, 2023. She was 78 years old.

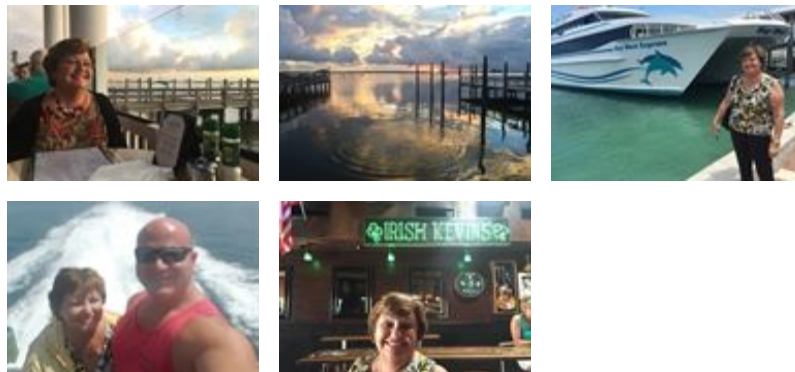
