



## Caroline F. Kneavel

A Funeral Liturgy will be celebrated for Caroline F. Kneavel formerly of 201 Federal Street, Easton, MD, on Thursday, March 27, 2003, at St. Peter's Catholic Church, in Queenstown, MD, at 11:00AM. Mrs. Kneavel died at the Ruxton Health Care Center, in Denton, MD, on Sunday, March 23, 2003. She was 101.

Born in Baltimore on August 8, 1901, she was the daughter of the late Philip and Mary Bartos Noha. After attending public school, she married Thomas C. Kneavel, Sr., a photo engraver in August of 1921. They made their home in Baltimore where he worked as a photo engraver until 1944 when they purchased a confectionary store. They operated the business known as the School Store which was located on East 35th Street, in Waverly, until 1963 when they moved to Grasonville. Following Mr. Kneavel's death in 1978, she moved to Easton where she lived until becoming a resident of the Wesleyan Nursing Center in Denton in February of 1988.

Mrs. Kneavel is survived by two daughters Ruth N. Kovatch of Easton, MD, and Naomi R. Kuchta, of Tucson, AZ; a son, Dr. Thomas C. Kneavel, Jr. (Dr. Ann C. Kneavel) of Hockessin, DE; and five grandchildren, Thomas L. Lane, James W. Kovatch, Dr. Meredith Kneavel-Boyd, Thomas C. Kneavel, III, and Rebecca A. Kneavel. Her brother, Charles Noha, and sister, Emma Canton, are deceased.
