Caroline H. Hilderbrandt, 73, of Easton, MD, passed away on December 13, 2012, at the Talbot Hospice House.

She was born April 6, 1939, in Bloomsburg, PA, the daughter of the late John Charles and Mary Caroline Berwind Housenick. She attended Wilson College in Chambersburg, PA; Bloomsburg University of PA; and Pennsylvania State University. Carol was the president of Compass Travel in Columbia, MD. Previously she was employed at Pennsylvania State University, Johnson and Roy in Ann Arbor, MI; and LDR International and American International, both in Columbia, MD.
